

Ordinance No. 1984-29 Trailer Coaches

An Ordinance to define and regulate the operation and use of trailer coaches.

THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH RANGE ORDAINS:

Section 1. Definition: For the purpose of this Ordinance, "trailer coach" means any vehicle or trailer of less than 1,000 square feet total floor area with or without motive power, designed for carrying property or persons and for being drawn by a motor vehicle, and so constructed as to permit occupancy as a dwelling or sleeping place by one or more persons, and including trailer coaches or self-propelled vehicles which have been reconstructed, altered or added to and having as a foundation wheels, jacks, piled concrete or wood blocks or skirtings.

Section 2. On or after the effective date hereof, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to use or permit the use of any trailer coach as a residence on any site, lot, field or tract of land within the limits of the Village of South Range.

~~Section 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than \$100.00 or by imprisonment of not more than 90 days in the County Jail or by both such fine and imprisonment. Any person so convicted shall be ordered to pay court costs.~~

Amended by 2017 Civil Infraction Ordinance:

Converted ordinance violations from misdemeanor offenses to municipal civil infractions and established civil fine schedules.

This Ordinance shall take effect on August 22, 1984.
