

Ordinance No. 1984-9 Minor Curfew

An Ordinance establishing a curfew for persons under 16 years of age.

THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH RANGE ORDAINS:

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person under the age of sixteen years to be abroad upon any of the streets, alleys, or public grounds of the Village of South Range between the hours of 10:00 P.M. and 4:00 A.M. from March 1st, to August 31st inclusive of each year or from September 1st, to the last day of February inclusive of each year between the hours of 9:00 P.M. and 4:00 A.M. unless such child is accompanied by a parent or other person having the legal custody of such minor, or whose employment makes it necessary to be upon the streets, alleys or public places during the nighttime and after said hours specified.

Section 2. That it shall be unlawful for any person, guardian or other person having legal custody of any child under sixteen years of age to allow or permit any such child, ward or other person under such age, while in such legal custody and without the accompaniment of a guardian or legal custodian, to go or be upon any of the public streets, alleys or public places in said Village, within the time provided by Section 1 of this Ordinance, unless there exists a reasonable necessity therefore.

Section 3. Any child violating the provisions of this Ordinance or any person as a parent, guardian or other person, having the legal care and custody of any child, who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00 or by imprisonment of not more than 90 days in the County jail or by both such fine and imprisonment. Any person so convicted shall be ordered to pay court costs.

~~Section 4. It shall be the duty of the Marshall or such other officer as the Village Council shall designate to ring the fire bell or siren of the Village each evening one time at the respective hour herein set forth.~~
