

## **Ordinance No. 1990-2 Amending 1984-21**

An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 1984-21 regulating the collection and disposition of garbage, charges therefore and penalties.

The Village of South Range ordains:

Ordinance No. 1984-21 is hereby amended by the repeal of existing Section 7 and the enactment of the following Section 7:

Section 7. Delinquent garbage service charge: If any billing for garbage services shall remain unpaid the amount thereof shall constitute a lien on property to which such service is provided. If any delinquency extends beyond 30 days from the date of billing the Village Clerk shall serve notice by certified mail, return receipt requested, to the owner of the premises receiving such service that if the total amount owed is not paid in full within five days of such notice the garbage service will be terminated until payment is made in full. Any garbage service charges delinquent for six months or more shall be certified annually, on March 1, by the Village Clerk to the assessor who shall place the same on the next tax role of the Village. Such charges so assessed shall be collected in the same manner as general Village taxes. In addition, the Village may, at its discretion, require an advance deposit of \$25.00 as a protection against future delinquencies prior to re-instituting garbage collection. The deposit shall be refunded without interest when the premises is no longer occupied or if the Village Council decides the deposit is no longer required.

The rates to be charged and paid for garbage collection by the Village shall be those rates as are set by the South Range Village council from time to time.

This Ordinance shall take effect on May 23, 1990.
