

Ordinance No. 2004-1 Compression Braking

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF MOTOR VEHICLE COMPRESSION BRAKING SYSTEMS IN NON-EMERGENCY SITUATIONS.

THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH RANGE ORDAINS:

Section 1. THE USE OF COMPRESSION BRAKES IS PROHIBITED.

Except in an emergency the use of compression engine brakes or similar engine braking devices also known as "exhaust brakes" or "Jake brakes" is prohibited within the Village limits if the noise level emitted during such use is greater than when not in use under identical engine and speed conditions.

Section 2.

Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be guilty of a municipal civil infraction punishable by a fine of not more than \$500.00 or by imprisonment of not more than 90 days in the county jail or both such fine and imprisonment.

This Ordinance shall become effective on January 1, 2005.
