

Ordinance No. 2007-3 Tourist Signs

An Ordinance to authorize the installation of Tourist Oriented Directional signs within the Village of South Range

The Village of South Range ordains:

As used in this ordinance:

- a. "Tourist oriented activity" means a lawful cultural, historical, recreational, educational or commercial activity that is attended by 2,000 or more people and for which a major portion of the activity's income or visitors are derived during the normal business season from motorists not residing in the immediate area of the activity.
- b. "Tourist orientated directional sign" means a sign used to provide motorists with advance notice of a tourist orientated activity.

Section 1

Tourist orientated directional signs may be installed within the jurisdictional limits of the Village of South Range in accordance with MCL 247.401 and MCL 247.403.

Section 2

The operator of a tourist orientated activity who wishes to participate in a directional sign program under MCL 247.401 and MCL 247.403 shall submit the required application for a tourist orientated directional sign to the Village of South Range for approval. Upon receipt of the application and any applicable fee, the application shall be acted upon by the village council.

Section 3

The operator of a tourist orientated activity that is permitted to install a tourist orientated directional sign shall be solely responsible for all annual cost and required payments associated with the installation, maintenance, and removal of the tourist orientated directional sign.

This Ordinance shall become effective on November 30, 2007.

This ordinance was adopted by the Village Council of the Village of South Range at a regular meeting held on the 1st day of November, 2007.
