

The Village of South Range was awarded a Community Technical, Managerial, and Financial Support for Lead Service Line Replacement Grant through the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE). The grant is being used to perform water service line material verification throughout the Village where existing water service materials are currently unknown. Water service material verification will occur at a total of 4 locations along the water service, including at the service line connection to the watermain and on each side of the curb stop, typically at the property line. The Village has contracted with National Industrial Maintenance Services to perform hydro excavation at these three locations on a total of 52 water services within the Villages service area. National Industrial Maintenance will be in the Village starting August 12 with an anticipated completion date of August 28, 2024. Village Department of Public Works staff will be completing the material verification at the fourth location within the residence or business below the water meter, interior verifications will be performed through October 2024. No interruptions of water service are anticipated as part of this project. If you have any questions, please contact the Village office at 906.482.8833
